

**Kiwanis Club of New Scotland

Parent Information**

1. **The league's primary goals are to foster fair competition, sportsmanship and good fellowship among participants, while promoting their knowledge and enjoyment of baseball.**
2. The league is open to all boys and girls ages 5 – 12 years old who reside in the Town of New Scotland.
3. The Kiwanis Club league commissioners are responsible for recruiting managers and coaches of each team, organizing teams, establishing rules of play, training umpires, ordering uniforms and supervision of the league.
4. **The season will be from April 26, 2010 till June 5, 2010.** All weekday games will be at 6:00 PM at the Voorheesville Elementary School. Saturday games will be at the Voorheesville Elementary School at 9:30AM (TBall and Big Sticks) and at 11:30AM (Minors and Majors).
IMPORTANT: PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE ROAD OR IN THE BUS LOT AND ACCESS CIRCLE OF VOORHEESVILLE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. YOU MAY BE TICKETED!
5. **All players are required to wear long pants** for each game as a safety precaution.
6. Only players, managers, coaches and umpires are allowed on the field.
7. The decisions of the umpires are final. **We ask that all spectators be respectful to them.** Remember the kids are following your example!
8. All questions should be brought to the team manager who will refer them to the Kiwanis league commissioners.
9. Generally the rules of youth baseball are followed.
10. The T-Ball and Big Sticks games are 3 innings. The Minor games are 4 innings and the Major games are 5 innings.
